## COVID-19 REMINDERS & QUARANTINE RULES

Residents under quarantine are required to stay at home for 14 days from date of exposure. Severe cases require 20 days of isolation. We are monitoring residents for any symptoms. While quarantining, residents are restricted to only their home and immediate yard. Access to common areas such as dining, The Scoop and the dog park are prohibited. As a precaution, if you are not feeling well for any reason, please contact the resident nurse immediately at extension 1407, the gatehouse, or use your pull cord. Approval must be received to be removed from quarantine/isolation. If you elect to be tested immediately quarantine until test results are received. If you have had exposure to someone who has tested positive use extreme caution and monitor yourself for any signs or symptoms. We can't stress enough how important it is to be safe during the holiday season. **Wear your mask, Social Distance, Wash your hands frequently, avoid large groups and be smart when traveling.**

### INDEPENDENT LIVING RESIDENT VISITATION (See Portal for updates.)

**Please let first time visitors know they need to keep their pink visitor passes if they plan to return at a later date. You may have up to 6 visitors. Complete the Visitor access form.** All general visitors must review the video on JKV's YouTube page located at [youtu.be/gXCdhGOQs6M](https://youtu.be/gXCdhGOQs6M) Prior to visiting, residents must complete the "JKV General Visitor Screening" form and inform the Gatehouse to enter Village through Gatehouse 1 (901 Veterans Memorial Park) to receive the pink Visitor Pass. Copies of the form are available at the Barker Center or you can print one off the Portal. **Submit completed pass to Resident Services in the Barker Center 3 times a week Monday-Friday.** Visitor passes will be available after 4:30p at Gatehouse 1. Passes should not have more than 2 visitors at a time in their homes. JKV reserves the right to revoke visitation should it become necessary.
